

19th Century Rustic Narrow Coffee Table or Bench with Peg Legs



The appeal of this rustic oak coffee table comes from the thick wood top that originally served as a worktable. The splayed peg legs were a traditional element in this type of table. Due to its narrow depth, at 18" deep, it may also be used as a sturdy bench.

Note the many scratches, nicks, gouges, cracks and multiple stains that all combine to build the depth of character.
